 i) 37th Singapore – Malaysia Joint Meeting in Ophthalmology & 2nd Global Young Ophthalmologist (YO Summit), 19 – 21 January 2024

SSO will be hosting the 37^{th} Singapore-Malaysia Joint Meeting in Ophthalmology from 19-21 January 2024 at the Academia (Singapore General Hospital Campus), Singapore.

The theme of the meeting is "Transforming Paradigms in Ophthalmology". It will be our first in-person regional meeting after 2 years since the pandemic. Aside from the usual plenary and symposia sessions featuring the newest trends and latest innovations that will transform the way we practice, other highlights include the 2nd Global Young Ophthalmologist (YO) Summit featuring prominent YO speakers from around the world on 19 January 2024; complementary hands-on imaging workshop; Basic Phacoemulsification and Minimally Invasive Glaucoma Surgery (MIGS) wet lab instruction courses as well as nursing and allied health programme.
