The Chao Tzee Cheng Professorship in Pathology and Forensic Science aims to continue promulgating the efforts that Professor Chao initiated to educate the medical, legal, scientific communities and the public, that forensic medicine is a vitally important science that reveals facts and aids in the pursuit of truth and justice.

A target sum of \$1.5 million will be raised for this professorship. In support of this worthy project, the Government will match all donations three times through the NUS Endowment Fund. The income generated from this Fund will be used to engage eminent professors in the field of pathology and forensic science for periods

ranging from three months to a year or more to share their expertise and experience. Particular emphasis will be given to the contributions and insights they can offer to Singapore and its ever-growing regional and international role. It is also envisaged that they will co-operate in research and education with other faculty members.
