1. THE NEW SMA COMPLAINTS AND SMA ETHICS COMMITTEE

One of the changes in the Committees is the SMA Ethics Committee.

Its activities have been reorganised to be handled by two Committees: the new SMA Complaints Committee and the SMA Ethics Committee.

The new SMA Complaints Committee

will handle all medico-legal complaints and complaints regarding practice matters as expeditiously as possible. Only complaints that involve ethical principles of medical practice will be referred to the SMA Ethics Committee for deliberation. The latter will also be concerned with the strategic approach to ethical and legal issues related to practice and will take the initial steps to discuss and formulate statements on ethical matters to guide the membership.

The offence is punishable with a fine of up to \$\$4,000 or a jail term not exceeding one year or both.
