1. AUTOCLAVE INSPECTION AND REGISTRATION

The Occupational Safety Department (OSD) of MOM would like to remind all medical practitioners that it has been four months since the issue was first raised. Although MOM understands that SMA Members would need time to have their existing or new autoclaves inspected and registered, they have emphasised that in the meantime, all necessary measures should be taken to ensure the safe use of their existing autoclaves.

2. SUSPENSION OF PRODUCT LICENCE OF LIPOBAY

The Health Sciences Authority (HSA) is suspending with immediate effect the product licence and marketing in Singapore of Lipobay (active in-gredient: cerivastatin). Lipobay, a prescription-only medicine, is an anti-cholesterol preparation manufactured by Bayer Germany.

This is a precautionary measure to safeguard public health following the voluntary worldwide withdrawal of the product by the company.
