News from SMA Council

1. HEALTH GUIDE BY SINGTEL YELLOW PAGES

We have been receiving queries from Members pertaining to the Health Guide by Singtel Yellow Pages and the latter's publicity material inviting doctors to be listed in the new Health Guide with options to enhance their listing.

We have since written to the Licensing & Accreditation Unit of MOH, who have responded that they have no objection to the free listing of the healthcare establishments in the new Health Guide provided that:

- The directory must contain a complete listing of all licensed healthcare institutions as published by the Ministry of Health in the Government Gazette.
- ii. The Advertising Guidelines issued under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act and Regulations are strictly adhered to.

However, MOH would not approve of the options to enhance the listing at a reasonable rate as proposed by SingTel Yellow Pages, as this might be construed as direct advertisements of healthcare institutions.

2. USE OF MEDICAL LASERS FOR HAIR REMOVAL IN NON-MEDICAL PREMISES

Under the Radiation Protection (Non-Ionising Radiation) Regulations 1991, only medical doctors are granted N3 licences allowing them to operate Class IV lasers. As hair removal using Class IV lasers has recently been classified as a medical procedure, to be performed only in medical establishments, the Centre for Radiation Protection had imposed conditions on the N2 (possession) and N3 (operation) licences restricting the operation of such lasers only to medical establishments which are licensed under the PHMC Act. This was done since June 2001.

At the present, N3 licences are only granted to medical doctors who have indicated that they have received the necessary training in laser safety.
