SMA is seeking advice, including legal advice, on how to safeguard the integrity and confidentiality of information in the online forum.

In conclusion, we would like to seek the cooperation of every member to play his/her part in ensuring the discussion forum will remain a site that is "strictly restricted to SMA Members only".
