Case 1

Mdm Fatimah, whose whole family regularly sees you at the Advance Island Polyclinic, came to ask you for help. Apparently, her uncle, Mr Ali is admitted to the ICU of SGH. She sounded anxious and claimed that the immediate family have not been told of the uncle's condition. She wanted you to use EMR Xchange to help her find out about her uncle's condition...

Miss Naidu stormed into your clinic, and accused you of causing her mom's readmission to the hospital. Miss Naidu's mom sustained a fall and stable head injury after an episode of postural hypotension. Apparently, during her mom's last visit to your clinic, you continued her usual medications, without knowing that during her recent hospitalisation, her antihypertensive agent was changed to another class. The miscommunication was due to a computer system failure on the day of her visit, and you were not able to access the EMR Xchange. Miss Naidu found it inexcusable as you now have access to the hospital record, and should know what is going on....
