Some Truths about Ethics

From this interlocked churning, perhaps Aristotle's practical wisdom will emerge – practitioners with moral will and moral skill, practitioners who will bring to the bedside a dedicated practice of valuing service over reward. The SMA CMEP is our beacon to guide fellow travellers onwards on such a journey.
