SMA Honorary Membership

First instituted in 1969, the SMA Honorary Membership is the highest honour that SMA can bestow upon individuals who are distinguished in public life or who have rendered meritorious service to the medical

profession or to the Association. This year's recipient was none other than Prof Tan Chorh Chuan.

Adj Prof Tan Sze Wee, SMA Council Member, took to the stage to deliver the citation on Prof John Wong's behalf, as he was unable to attend the dinner in person. The citation for Prof Tan Chorh Chuan illustrated his many contributions to medicine over the past 30 years (see page 12). Minister Ong Ye Kung presented the SMA Honorary Membership to Prof Tan Chorh Chuan.

A tribute to frontliners

Another highlight of this year's Annual Dinner was the launch of the artbook collaboration between SMA and local illustrator Mr Josef Lee titled *Unmasking the Extraordinary*. Minister Ong Ye Kung and Dr Tan Yia Swam officially launched the book amid applause and enthusiastic support for the project.

A collection of 36 comics – illustrated short stories based on real-life experiences of healthcare workers (HCWs) alongside heartfelt quotes from HCWs – the book captures the sacrifices and spirit of frontliners amid the COVID-19 pandemic and is intended as a tribute to everyone on the frontline. Just as our HCWs have given their best and all to support Singapore through the pandemic challenges, the collaboration seeks to give back to the medical field by donating all proceeds from the book to the SMA Charity Fund, which supports medical students from disadvantaged families.

SMA Merit Award

Awarded to individuals who have made significant contributions to SMA and the medical profession, or social service to the community, the SMA Merit Award was presented to three recipients this year.

Prof Anantharaman Venkataraman

is an emeritus consultant at Singapore General Hospital, and widely regarded as the "Father of Emergency Medicine" in Singapore. In his 47 years of distinguished service in the public healthcare sector, Prof Anantharaman has a track record of leadership and innovation in the field of emergency medicine and disaster management planning. He is also the first Singaporean to be awarded the Order of the International Federation for Emergency Medicine.

A/Prof Low Yin Peng is an emeritus consultant at Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH). He was the head and senior consultant of the Orthopaedic Surgery Department at TTSH from 1988 to 2001, where he developed subspecialisations for spine, hand, trauma, ankle and foot, sports and joint reconstruction surgeries. In his distinguished career, he served as the president of the Singapore Orthopaedic Association (1984–1985), Singapore Society for Hand Surgery (1990–1991), and College of Surgeons, Singapore (2009–2011).

Prof Leo Yee-Sin is the executive director of the National Centre for
