MEDICAL PROFESSIONALISM: Professional Standards in the Care of the Vulnerable Adult

Healthcare professionals providing care to vulnerable adults should ensure that their clinical practice meets the expected standards of care and that they are familiar with the relevant laws that apply to this group of patients.

The Vulnerable Adults Act (VAA) aims to protect vulnerable adults from abuse, neglect or self-neglect, and to provide timely and effective interventions to prevent further abuse or neglect. This webinar will discuss how the VAA legislation came about, its relevance and applications in clinical practice for healthcare professionals, and also explore the standards of care expected in managing vulnerable adults.
