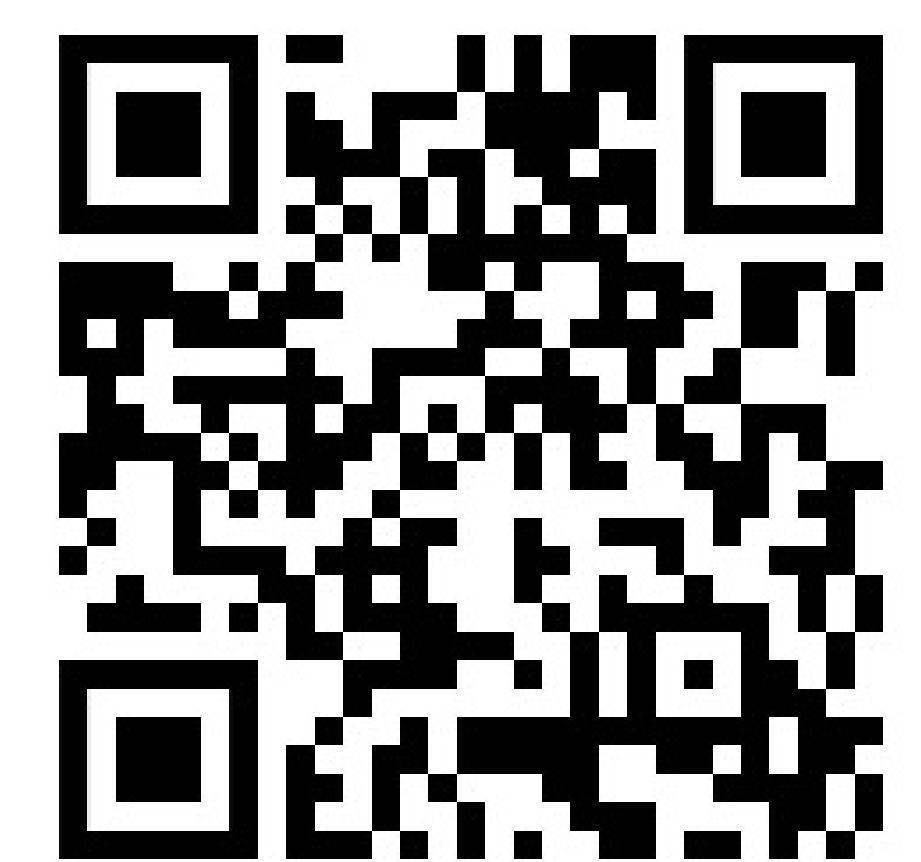

## KEY SPEAKERS



**Dr Law Weng Giap**  
Rheumatologist

Dr Law Weng Giap is a Rheumatologist with special interest in diagnostic and interventional musculoskeletal ultrasound. He is also adept in nailfold videocapillaroscopy for the early diagnosis of Scleroderma and other vasculopathies and vasculitides. He chaired the National Healthcare Group Rheumatology Residency Programme at Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH), and was the site Principal Investigator and Collaborator of several clinical trials in Systemic Sclerosis and Psoriatic Arthritis. He has more than 20 years' experience in managing various complicated autoimmune diseases including Systemic Lupus Erythematosus, Systemic Sclerosis and Myositis, as well as various forms of inflammatory arthritides such as Rheumatoid Arthritis, Psoriatic Arthritis and Ankylosing Spondylitis.



**Dr Tan Teck Choon**  
Rheumatologist, Clinical Immunologist & Allergist

Dr Tan Teck Choon trained at TTSH in Internal Medicine, Rheumatology, Allergy and Immunology, and subsequently completed an MOH HDMP fellowship programme in musculoskeletal ultrasound and laboratory immunology at the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital in Sydney, Australia. Upon his return, he introduced a novel autoantibody test assay for the identification of inflammatory myopathies, which has become the standard of care. He served as Head of Division in Rheumatology, Allergy and Immunology at Khoo Teck Puat Hospital (KTPH), and concomitantly held the position of Assistant Chairman Medical Board (Manpower & Medical Affairs) from 2021 to 2024. He is the current Board Chair, Section of Clinical Immunologists & Allergists, Academy of Medicine Singapore. He was the lead discussant of the ACE clinical guidance of 2019 on Gout, last updated in 2023.



**Dr Grace Chan**  
Rheumatologist, Clinical Immunologist & Allergist

Dr Grace Chan is the current President of the Allergy and Clinical Immunology Society and a Board Member on both Lupus Association and Section of Clinical Immunologists and Allergists, Academy of Medicine Singapore. As a former senior consultant at the Department of Rheumatology, Allergy and Clinical Immunology TTSH, she led the allergy service and was the Program Director of training. Her interests lie in the diagnosis and management of drug allergy and desensitisation, which was the focus of her overseas training at Brigham and Women's hospital in Boston, USA. Dr Chan has extensive experience in treating complex autoimmune conditions, allergic diseases and immunodeficiencies.



**Dr Eugene Lim**  
Rheumatologist

Dr Eugene Lim's management philosophy, "Fast and Furious, Treat to Target, with Whatever It Takes", characterises his approach to the Inflammatory Arthritides and Autoimmune/Autoinflammatory Diseases. He identified point-of-care ultrasound as key to early diagnosis, and to guide therapeutic intervention. This drove his pursuit of continual training, attaining accreditations as a EULAR musculoskeletal ultrasound trainer and as a World Institute of Pain (WIP)-certified interventional pain sonologist. He also undertook a fellowship programme with the Pain School International, equipping him with skills for interventional pain management and regenerative therapy, to more effectively treat degenerative rheumatic conditions such as Osteoarthritis and Soft Tissue Rheumatism.
