**1. 30th Singapore-Malaysia Joint Meeting in Ophthalmology,
22 – 24 August 2014, Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel**

More than 300 delegates, speakers and chairpersons attended the meeting with the theme 'Imaging: Ophthalmology in High-Definition'. Invited speakers from Switzerland, Australia, India, Malaysia as well as Singapore spoke on new technologies and gave their insights on how these tools enable ophthalmologists to access structures in and around the eye. The meeting received much positive feedback from both overseas delegates and speakers.

More than 40 residents, trainees and ophthalmologists from Malaysia and Singapore attended the event which was held in conjunction with the 30th Singapore-Malaysia Joint Meeting in Ophthalmology.


The event succeeded in its aim to promote interaction and collaboration amongst ophthalmologists in Singapore and Malaysia, especially the trainees and residents.

3. Mobile Eye Clinic Project (Seeing is Believing)


SSO partnered with Standard Chartered Bank on a two-year Mobile Eye Clinic project that aims to bring eye care to the elderly members in the community who do not qualify for our local healthcare system, or are unable to have access to healthcare due to physical or logistical barriers. A total of 4 screenings were conducted last year namely at Chin Swee Road, Taman Jurong, Bright Hill Evergreen Home at Punggol and North Bridge Road, benefitting a total of 670 needy elderly. 352 elderly were identified with eye conditions requiring further follow-up with an eye specialist. A further 12 patients were diagnosed with Cataract during the screenings and underwent free cataract surgery at Mount Elizabeth Orchard Hospital.
