1. <u>28th Singapore-Malaysia Joint Meeting in Ophthalmology, in conjunction with the XIX</u> International Neuro-Ophthalmology Society Meeting

- This conference was attended by more than 600 delegates from 32 countries, including more than 100 Malaysians.
- The XIX International Neuro-Ophthalmology Society Meeting, held for the first time in South East Asia, had an extensive programme which featured many eminent Neuro-ophthalmology clinicians and researchers from around the world sharing on the latest update on various topics, including hereditary optic neuropathies, vascular disorders in Neuro-ophthalmology, imaging, visual rehabilitation.
- There were separate concurrent sessions under the Singapore-Malaysia Joint
  Meeting to update the general ophthalmologists on the advances in cataract and
  refractive technology. There was also a half-day paramedic programme.

#### 3. Mission Eye Work

Leh Mission Trip

July/August 2012

• This mission trip was led by Dr Marcus Ang and comprised a team of opthalmologists (including Dr Tay Su Ann and Dr Don Pek), optometrists and nurses from various institutions, who examined and treated over 3,000 villagers and children in Leh and

Ladakh, India, with a wide range of specialised vision and general health procedures and treatments over ten days. Patients were taught how to protect their eyes and simple ways to improve their vision — with spectacles, eye drops, etc — and the medical team also trained local optical technicians and Ophthalmology residents on the usage of slit lamps, tonopens, treatment of basic eye conditions and eye drop prescriptions.
