As PCP provides a vast database of information through a single point of access for all healthcare professionals, it functions as a dynamic digital hub and credible source that keep all industry insiders in the loop on the latest updates.

Why you should use it

Healthcare professionals can access Continuing Medical Education (CME) events on the PCP calendar, which is constantly updated with training sessions and forums. PCP

also features updates from the Ministry of Health, alongside information on chronic diseases, drugs, health products and clinical practice guidelines. If you need to assist your patients in making referrals, various restructured hospitals and specialist outpatient clinics' medical forms and appointment hotlines are available on PCP. Healthcare professionals can also read up on initiatives and developments in primary care on this online portal, such as updates on the Community Health Assist Scheme, Community Health Centres and Pandemic Preparedness Clinics.

PCP encourages healthcare professionals to list their clinics on its Health Professional Directory page so that patients can search for them easily, as well as register for courses and talks under the CMEs and Events category for self-improvement or a deeper understanding of topics related to primary care. The E-Request feature on PCP also allows healthcare professionals to request for brochures to be displayed at their clinics or even for a visit from an AIC staff to provide detailed explanation on various healthcare initiatives, at a time of your convenience.
