Doctor

You will be responsible for providing palliative care to patients assigned to you. Such care includes patient assessment, patient care planning, implementing and monitoring of symptom management. You will be involved in training and orientation of other medical professionals who may be attached to HCA from time to time. You will also represent HCA in dealing with other institutions/agencies and participate in community programmes to create awareness of HCA's work to the community and institutions/agencies.

You are encouraged to initiate and participate in continual learning and development programmes that may also include research or quality improvement projects. Training opportunities are also widely available, either at diploma or specialist levels.

You will be on a 5-day workweek. However, you will be required to undertake on-call responsibilities outside normal working hours.
